MEMORANDUM AND ORDER  
(Updated General Schedule)

I. Revised General Schedule

In a March 30, 2011 issuance, the Licensing Board outlined an updated general schedule for conducting the uncontested/mandatory hearing process for this 10 C.F.R. Part 70 proceeding concerning National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA)/environmental matters. See Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Updated General Schedule) (Mar. 30, 2011) (unpublished). That schedule included dates that anticipated participation in the NEPA/environmental portion of this proceeding by one or more interested governmental entities (IGEs). See id. at 3. No IGEs have sought to take part, however. Consequently, the Board has decided to modify the due date applicable to evidentiary hearing-related filings to provide additional time for such submissions by applicant AREVA Enrichment Services, LLC, (AES) and the NRC staff, extending the filing deadline from June 24, 2011, to Friday, July 1, 2011. That revision is reflected in the revised general schedule included as Appendix A to this issuance.
