Here is a the call summary of the discussion we had regarding Financial Assurance. Thanks.

On May 26, 2011, the NRC and International Isotopes Inc. (INIS) held a conference call to discuss follow-up questions to the responses for the financial assurance requests for additional information (RAI). The NRC staff had 6 follow-up questions about FA-2, FA-5 and FA-7, see attached. The NRC staff asked how remaining inventories of DUF4 and DUF6 would be disposed of at decommissioning and whether the costs of disposal are included in the cost estimates. The costs have not been included, but INIS will provide the necessary information in response to the follow-up RAIs. The data and calculations in the financial assurance tables were discussed. INIS plans to update the tables to improve clarity. They also indicated that future updates regarding financial assurance would be provided to the NRC on a regular schedule consistent with the regulatory requirements and applicable license conditions.

The NRC staff will provide the follow-up questions as formal RAIs.
