As we discussed, the class that was held for all Mid-Atlantic North Office Managers and RSOs was conducted on May 11, 2011. Your newly-assigned RSO for the Waldorf Office, Mr. Ajakaye was present, and he had recently completed an online Radiation Safety Officer course.


To follow-up on these two initial training events, it was proposed that we would conduct an educational audit of the Waldorf Radiation Safety Program. This was accomplished on May 18, 2011. We were quite impressed with Mr. Ajakaye's desire and motivation to excel, and what he had already learned to-date for the proper conduct of a Radiation Safety Program.

Obviously, more time and effort will be required before he becomes totally comfortable with the range of skills, knowledge and procedures that are necessary to run a fully effective program. However, we have no hesitation in giving our recommendations that his assignment be finalized and reflected on both the NRC and the MDE Radioactive Material licenses.

The details of the May 18, 2011 audit were left with Mr. Ajakaye prior to departure. This audit will be formally documented for record purposes.

As a follow-up, we will be more than happy to conduct another audit of Waldorf within the next 30 to 45 days to assist Mr. Ajakaye as appropriate and to help him become more comfortable in the conduct of his duties.
