Dear Mr. Galmarini:

On April 26, 2011, Héctor Bermúdez and Robin Elliott of this office conducted an on-site safety inspection at West Virginia Radiation Therapy Services, Inc., in Princeton, West Virginia. The inspection was an examination of your licensed activities as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's regulations and the license conditions. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspectors, interviews with personnel, and an examination of records. The findings of the inspection were discussed with Greg Madison at the conclusion of the inspection on April 26, 2011.

Based on the results of this inspection, no violations were identified and an NRC Form 591M was left on site indicating this. However, the inspectors continue to review an open item regarding how timer linearity is determined during each full calibration of your high dose rate remote afterloader (HDR) unit. This issue will remain open and the results of our review will be provided in future correspondence.
