URENCO USA – STANDARD PRACTICES PROCEDURE PLAN FOR THE PROTECTION OF CLASSIFIED MATTER AT THE URENCO USA, REVISION 9

In my letter of June 1, 2011, comments were provided on the subject document. Based upon discussions between Tyrone Naquin of your staff, Roger Holt - Department of Energy (DOE), and Jim Hutson - Pro2Serve on June 2, 2011, a portion of comment 2 conflicts with previous DOE direction regarding the Information System Security Manager and Information System Security Officer. Please disregard the comments in my June 1, 2011, letter and replace with the following:

1. Section 13.5, Portion Marking, Page 61 – remove Restricted Data (RD) from this section. RD is not portion marked.
2. Section 26.0, Information Technology Security Requirements for Classified Networks, Page 96-97 – revise substantive changes to include expansion of the current network perimeter.

Please request that Louisiana Energy Services incorporate these changes and re-submit for DOE's review.
