Dr. Chute,

I had one concern on your NRC License. It says in item 8A, 1 mCi per source and 1000 mCi total. The way we normally license unsealed material of atomic number 1-83 would be 1 mCi per radionuclide and 1000 mCi total. Looking at the application, that is how this is stated. i.e. 1 mCi per source is kind of meaningless for unsealed materials.

Anyways, I was going to change it to 1 mCi per radionuclide and 1000 mCi total. I just wanted to make sure that this would work with your program as the license had stated something other than that.
