Subject: Summary of 5/2/11 meeting w/NFS re: Construction of New Entry/Exit Control Point

On May 2, 2011, a closed meeting was conducted with Nuclear Fuel Services to discuss physical protection plan revisions resulting from the construction of a new Entry/Exit Control Point. The following individuals participated:

Meeting slides presented by NFS are available at ML111240084. These slides are non-public because they are Official Use Only – Security related Information. NFS stated that it plans to submit a revised physical security plan by the end of June. The revision will add an addendum describing planned changes to the plan as each phase of construction is completed. NFS believes these changes improve the effectiveness of its security program and may be made without prior NRC approval under 70.32. NFS noted that the planned construction was coordinated with its emergency preparedness staff and it had identified no need for changes to the NFS Emergency Plan.

After the briefing, NRC staff agreed that the planned changes appeared to upgrades which NFS can make without prior NRC approval. However, NRC will review the addendum when it is submitted to confirm that finding. In addition, the information presented by NFS will be shared with security inspectors in RII to determine if they have any concerns.
