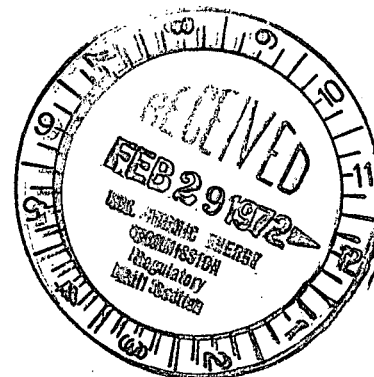

Dear Mr. DeYoung:

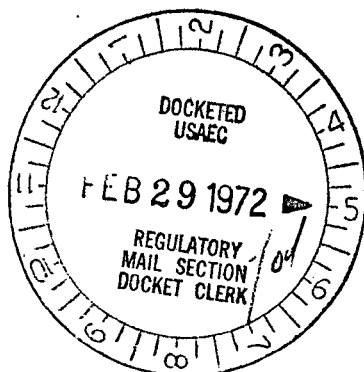
With your letter of January 28, you enclosed a program for inservice inspection for detection of effects of reactor coolant leakage. About the same time that your letter was received we also received a telephone transmitted question, "What means is WPS providing to prevent exposure of the reactor vessel closure studs to vapor or moisture from borated water or other potential corrosive media when the reactor vessel head is removed?"

Evaluation of these two items is taking a little longer than we expected, and we ask for your indulgence to extend the time of reply an additional 30 days or until March 28.
