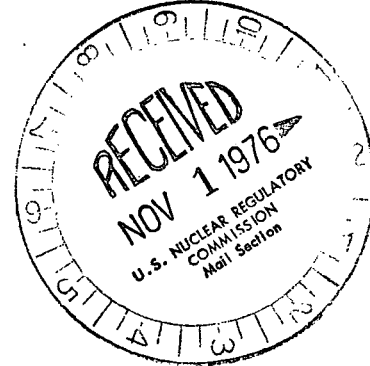

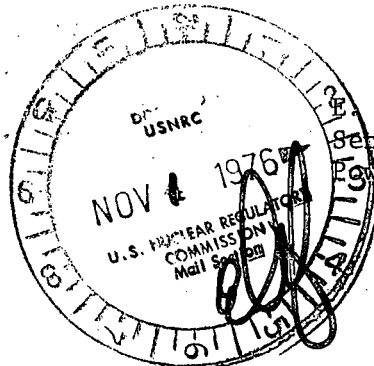
The referenced letter requested that we submit within 45 days of receipt of the letter, our request for a license amendment addressing the in-service inspection of steam generators.

A draft of the requested Technical Specification has been prepared for the Kewaunee Plant. That draft is currently being reviewed by our engineering staff and safety committees as required by our procedures and the Technical Specifications. A meeting of the Nuclear Safety Review and Audit Committee is scheduled for November 11. Due to the close proximity of the upcoming NSRAC meeting, a delay in submittal of the requested amendment is warranted. This delay would allow the NSRAC to review the proposed specification as a group and should provide a better specification. We, therefore, request that the submittal date for this proposed change be delayed until November 15, 1976.
