Your letter/survey of August 14, 1980, addresses the loss of offsite power. After reading the questionnaire we interpret that you are requesting information regarding the loss of offsite power resulting from grid failures such as severed power lines, etc.

A record search revealed that the Kewaunee Plant has experienced losses of power due only from specific incidents resulting from internal plant related failures (plant side of plant substation) such as a Reserve Auxiliary Transformer Bushing Failure and failure of Reserve Auxiliary Transformer Buswork.

Therefore, on the basis of our interpretation, Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant has not experienced any losses, complete or partial, of offsite power that relate to this survey in question.
