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

#### FITNESS FOR DUTY PROGRAM PERFORMANCE DATA PERSONNEL SUBJECT TO 10 CFR 26

MANAGEMENT ACTIONS TAKEN

- 1) Unescorted access was revoked on one individual due to a positive test result from the random test program.
- Five individuals were granted access contingent on Management imposed accelerated follow-up testing programs to verify successful rehabilitation.
- 3) "Other" tests consist of voluntary tests submitted to by Fitness for Duty Task Force members in an effort to ensure procedure compliance prior to official implementation.

DATA ANALYSIS RESULTS/PROGRAM CHANGES IMPLEMENTED

- A random computer program was written to select the day and shift for each random test date. Implementation began in May of 1990.
  Prior to that date, this selection was administratively controlled.
- 2) Two contractor Fitness for Duty Programs were evaluated and accepted by Kewaunee.
- 3) <u>O</u> positive tests on licensee employees during this reporting period is indicative of the reliable trustworthy workforce at Kewaunee.
