In its Order dated March 5, 2009, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Board") directed the NRC staff ("Staff") to tender each month a status report advising as to whether the estimated dates for issuance of the final Safety Evaluation Report ("SER") (predicted for the late summer of 2009) and the final environmental review document (predicted for December of 2009) have changed.¹ The Staff continues to expect to issue the SER by December 2011. Likewise, the Staff continues to expect to issue the final environmental review document by December 2011.

In keeping with the Board's mandate, the Staff will tender its next monthly status report by July 15, 2011.
