HR	U300	Specialized Skills Training	7	<p>These are highly qualified Technical Training Center instructors who possess a unique combination of competencies and associated knowledge and skills, including the requisite regulatory perspective. These skills include detailed technical and operational knowledge of multiple reactor designs, broad knowledge of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regulatory processes and programs, working level knowledge of Probabilistic Risk Assessment, and risk-informed regulation. They have demonstrated the ability to integrate regulatory and technical information and issues into training and qualification programs for regulators. These instructors are responsible for the design, development, implementation and maintenance of traditional classroom, simulator, self-study, and web-based training programs. These functions routinely require working with proprietary, sensitive, and pre-decisional business information. These instructors successfully implement the formal training programs identified by NRC staff qualification programs.</p>
OIP	Y440	Federal Licensing and Permitting	2	<p>The incumbents of this position are independently responsible for incorporating the provisions, requirements, conditions, and limitations required by NRC's regulations into licensing documents for export and import applications. This requires an inherent expert knowledge of NRC regulations for licensing, certification, enforcement, and inspection programs contained in Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations. It also requires an expert knowledge of technical terminology and an understanding of the legal principles related to working with international export/import licenses and other licensing documents. The licensing assistant represents an NRC core capability.</p>
