SUBJECT: PHONE CONVERSATION WITH WISCONSIN PUBLIC SERVICE ABOUT KEWAUNEE REVIEW,
DOCKET NO. 50-305

On December 6, 1967, Mr. R. C. Straub of Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPS) called to discuss the submission of additional information on the Kewaunee design. He said the changes that were being made in the design of the Prairie Island containment, engineered safeguards and reactor equipment would be made on Kewaunee, too. He said they expected to have detailed information of the type requested on Prairie Island as well as detailed foundation design ready to mail to us on December 28. I stressed the importance of submitting complete and detailed information and told him we would try to be prepared to discuss this information with them about 2 weeks after we received it.

I also told him we would write WPS a letter within the next few days which would point out the importance of prompt submission of information on these changes if our review schedule is to be maintained. He said he would welcome such a letter because it would help him get internal cooperation to speed up the preparation of the information.
