SUBJECT: PHONE CONVERSATION WITH WISCONSIN PUBLIC SERVICE ABOUT KEWAUNEE REVIEW,  
DOCKET NO. 50-305

On November 29 I called Mr. Evan James of Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPS) and asked to what extent the changes in the Prairie Island design would be reflected in Kewaunee. He did not have all the details on the changes, but expected most of the changes would be made in Kewaunee, too. In view of this I suggested that WPS submit information on Kewaunee of the type requested at the Prairie Island meeting of November 28 and 29. (Prairie Island and Kewaunee are identical in most respects and Pioneer Services and Engineering is AE for both plants.) I also suggested that this information plus foundation design be submitted prior to our next technical meeting, since major changes in containment and engineered safeguards are involved. He said this sounded like a good idea and said he would discuss it with Pioneer and contact me within the next few days, either by phone or by letter.
