DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:

By letter dated August 4, 1975, Wisconsin Public Service Corporation requested that the Facility Operating License and Technical Specifications for the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant be amended in accordance with our suggested standard licensing format relating to the receipt, possession, and use of special nuclear, byproduct, and source materials. The requested action will amend the license and Technical Specifications to agree with the provisions of Regulatory Guide 1.70.3.

It should be noted that the Eberline Model 1000 Multi-Source Calibrator is excepted from leak testing.

Kewaunee's submittal also includes supporting information in the form of changes to the FSAR.

It is requested that you review Kewaunee's submittal and provide us with a written response by October 1, 1975. In order for us to prepare an adequate safety evaluation, your review should determine if Kewaunee's submittal: (1) satisfies Regulatory Guide 1.70.3, (2) established an acceptable radiation protection program, and (3) provides reasonable assurance that the radioactive materials will be stored and used in a manner to meet the applicable radiation protection provisions of 10 CFR Parts 20, 30 and 70.
