About the end of November, it is expected that the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant will receive a full power operating license. There will be no restrictions on power level by the technical specifications or license condition. bill Wisconsin Public Service Commission for 1650 megawatts thermal.

We are also reviewing full power for Units 3 and 4 of Florida Power & Light Company's Turkey Point Plant, and expect to be able to approve this within the next several weeks. This would be an increase of approximately 154 megawatts thermal for Unit 4. It is my understanding the license fee for Unit 3 is already paid.
