Reference 1 requested Licensees to mark all pages of the Emergency Plan and Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures (EPIP's) which have private or proprietary information, bracket the specific information involved and identify these pages in the transmittal letter when they are submitted to the NRC. This was not done in our most recent submittal (Reference 2). We have verbally requested that these documents not be placed in the Public Document Room; this letter serves as verification of these requests

In reviewing our emergency plan implemeting procedures, we have concluded that the level of detail provided in the EPIP's (and all procedures in general) is inappropriate for public disclosure and should not be placed in the Public Document Room. Therefore, we are requesting that previously submitted EPIP's, as well as future submittals of EPIP's, be withheld from the Public Document Room.
