Dr. Kolodziej,

You responded on May 2, 2011 that you would resolve the pending issues with your requirement to provide financial assurance for the license listed above. On May 19, I received an email from your insurance broker, Mr. Urratia, requesting guidance on financial assurance instruments, which I provided on May 20. However, in that May 20 email, I also informed him that the Decommissioning Funding Plan (DFP), and the cost estimate based on the DFP, must be approved by the NRC. I still do not have a DFP or cost estimate submitted from you. In your January 24, 2011 letter, you stated that a DFP was attached, but that letter when it was received here did NOT have a DFP attached. I have attempted on 3 previous occasions to obtain the DFP that was supposed to be with the January 24 letter, but do not yet have it.

Please provide me with the current status of your DFP and cost estimate.
