



Our organization is committed to balanced and responsible development in and around northern San Luis Obispo County. Its purpose is to promote economic and environmental policies that maintain and enhance the uniqueness of our community. These comments are submitted on behalf of North County Watch (NCW) and our supporters.

Thank you for convening a meeting in San Luis Obispo to gather citizen commentary on the Diablo Nuclear Power Plant (DNPP). We wish to offer the following concerns regarding plant safety and impacts.

Many of the concerns expressed by residents of San Luis Obispo have been raised repeatedly for many years. Sadly, the events in Japan have illustrated how devastating a serious event at a nuclear plant can become. We hope that these events have instilled a new level of concern and vigilance regarding seismic and other safety issues related to DNPP.

We join Mothers for Peace and our community in requesting that you accelerate a thorough seismic study of the area; re-evaluate the potential for impacts to plant operation from tsunami; significantly increase oversight and enforcement procedures; review and strengthen procedures for emergency situations.

Thank you for addressing these and other significant safety and procedural issues at DNPP.
