Dear Mr. Bueche:

It has come to our attention that an omission existed in Amendment No. 01 to your NRC Material License No. 21-23325-02. This omission has been corrected by the addition of a total possession limit in Item 8.A. and 8.B in the enclosed Corrected Copy of License Amendment No. 01. Items 7.A. and 7.B were also modified to include the source manufacturer and Model Nos.

Due to a change in NRC's licensing policies, we must obtain possession limits for all materials listed on your license. As we discussed by telephone on March 11, 2011, we have listed the total possession limit for cesium-137 as 9 millicuries in Item 8.A. and americium-241 as 44 millicuries in Item 8.B.
