JOINT MOTION REGARDING JULY 2011 DISCLOSURES

Pursuant to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's Initial Scheduling Order and Administrative Directives (Prehearing Conference Call Summary, Grant of Joint Motion Regarding Mandatory Disclosures, Initial Scheduling Order, and Administrative Directives) dated March 30, 2011 ("Order"), Applicant Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), on behalf of itself, intervenors Mark Oncavage, Dan Kipnis, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, and National Parks Conservation Association (hereinafter referred to collectively as "Joint Intervenors") and Citizens Allied for Safe Energy, Inc. ("CASE"), and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Staff ("NRC Staff") (collectively, "the Parties") hereby submits this joint motion regarding the July 2011 update to mandatory disclosures and the hearing file under 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.336(d) and 2.1203(c). The Parties request Board approval for a one-time change in the disclosure update deadline from July 8, 2011 to July 15, 2011.

The Order directs that the "Parties shall update their disclosures and the Hearing File on the second Friday of every month." Order at 5. In July 2011, the second Friday of the month is July 8, 2011. To accommodate the July 4th holiday week, the Parties have agreed to seek a one-time postponement of the disclosure deadline to the third Friday in July, which is July 15, 2011. The Parties would resume the normal disclosure schedule on the second Friday in August 2011.

The Parties respectfully request that the Board approve this agreement.

Counsel for FPL certifies that all Parties have given their consent for FPL to file this joint motion on their behalf.
