3 CHAIRMAN FARMAKIDES: The hearing will be in  
4 order.

5 Mr. Seiffert, I understand you have a motion to  
6 make or request to make.

7 MR. SEIFFERT: Yes, Mr. Chairman. I am authorized  
8 to state on behalf of all three parties; the Regulatory Staff,  
9 the Applicant and the Intervenor that all three parties have,  
10 in accordance with the suggestion of the Board that all parties  
11 attempt to continue to identify and simplify issues in this  
12 proceeding, the parties are in serious negotiation to that end.

13 We met all day Sunday in Cleveland, Ohio, all day  
14 yesterday in Chicago to that end since that process is  
15 continuing seriously I would request on behalf of all three  
16 parties that the Board recess the hearing until 1:00 p.m.  
17 today, at which time we will report again on the status of  
18 those negotiations.

19 CHAIRMAN FARMAKIDES: Thank you, Mr. Seiffert.

20 Your request is granted.

21 I might say this for the record: The Board was  
22 contacted Saturday with the thought that further negotiations  
23 are proceeding, the parties would all meet Sunday in Cleveland,  
24 Ohio, and I understand those have been completed.

25 Further discussions as you have just indicated

1 are underway. We think this is a very valuable process and  
2 the Board approves it. We think that this may resolve the  
3 great majority of the issues between the parties.

4 We will reconvene at 1:00 o'clock. Thank you.
