Dear Mr. Thomas:

On December 17, 2007, Uranerz Energy Corporation (Uranerz) submitted a license application, dated November 30, 2007, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a Source and Byproduct Materials License for the extraction and recovery of uranium at its Nichols Ranch In-Situ Recovery (ISR) Project. The application was amended by submissions from Uranerz dated March 11, 2009, February 24, 2010, and September 15, 2010. The NRC staff reviewed the amended application and developed a draft license that was sent to Uranerz on November 16, 2010. On December 20, 2010, the NRC staff held a public meeting with Uranerz to discuss the draft license conditions for the proposed Nichols Ranch ISR Project. By letter dated December 29, 2010, Uranerz provided revised language for some of the conditions in the draft license. Staff reviewed the proposed changes and provided a revised draft license to Uranerz on March 10, 2011. Staff sent a revised draft license to Uranerz dated June 14, 2011, but by this letter, is sending another revised draft although comments have not been received by Uranerz on the June 14, 2011 draft.

Please note that this revised draft license does not constitute a final licensing decision by the NRC staff. Please review the enclosed draft license and provide comments or confirmation that Uranerz agrees with these license conditions within 30 days of receipt of this letter. The staff is available to meet with you to discuss the draft license; however, a public meeting with Uranerz requires 10 days prior notice. Comments on this revised draft license can be provided via letter or email.
