On December 12, 1972, the Intervenor in the above captioned case filed a motion requesting the Board to vacate paragraph 4 of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's order of December 4, 1972, insofar as it required the Intervenor to file written direct testimony on January 15, 1973.

Counsel for the Intervenor has correctly stated the agreement reached by each of the parties with respect to filing written testimony in paragraph 1 of his motion.


In addition, the Regulatory Staff agrees that the proposed change to the transcript stated in the third paragraph of the footnote on page 4 of his motion is correct.
