CORRECTIONS TO THE AEC REGULATORY STAFF'S ANSWER TO PETITION TO INTERVENE FILED BY BUSINESSMEN FOR THE PUBLIC INTEREST AND POWER

1. On August 9, 1972, the Regulatory Staff filed the "AEC Regulatory Staff's Answer to Petition to Intervene Filed by Businessmen for the Public Interest and POWER". Answer number 5.B.(3) at page 4 should be corrected to read as follows:

"(3) The Regulatory Staff has no objections to contention numbers 3.2; and 3.4 through 3.16.1 insofar as these contentions are intended to question whether or not the Kewalnee Station has been constructed in conformity with the construction permit. Any contentions regarding matters which solely involve construction permit requirements are outside the scope of an operating license proceeding and should be rejected since such matters were dealt with during the construction permit proceeding. The regulatory staff believes this matter can be clarified in prehearing procedures."
