It has come to the attention of this office that the United States Atomic Energy Commission intends to hold public hearings on June 25th and 27th, 1968, relative to the establishment of two nuclear power generating facilities in Manitowoc and Kewaunee Counties, Wisconsin.

In Wisconsin, the Division of Resource Development, Department of Natural Resources, has been given the responsibility to protect, maintain and improve the quality and management of the waters of the State, ground and surface, public and private. Since these generating facilities will have waste discharges to Lake Michigan, this division may have an interest in the hearings June 25 and 27 and, as such, will have a representative in attendance who may wish to make a limited appearance as the interests of this division may dictate.

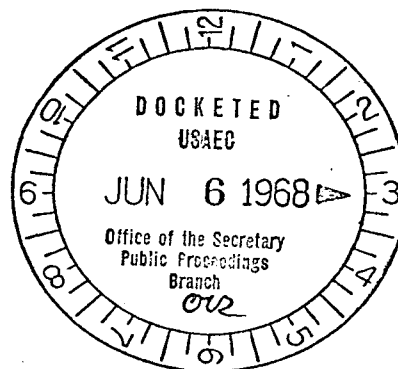
