SUBJECT: Diamond Ordnance Radiation Facility (DORF) - Annual Report

1. Reference:

a. Memorandum, Army Reactor Office, Nuclear Possession Permit, 3 Jun 97.

b. Memorandum, AMSRL-CS-IS-SH, 7 Mar 98, Subject: Diamond Ordnance Radiation Facility (DORF) - Detention Tank Removal.

2. This annual report is being submitted as required by conditions 13a through 13f of the subject permit. Permit condition numbers are indicated parenthetically for your convenience.

The structural condition of the facility remains unchanged 3. since issuance of the permit(13a). The radiological condition of the facility remains unchanged since issuance of the permit, with the exception of radioactive decay (13b). Photon radiation levels are approximately 30 microrem per hour at a distance of one meter from exposure room surfaces. Wipes tests taken during the semi-annual inspection indicate no removable contamination above a minimum detectable activity of 6 disintegrations per minute alpha and 35 disintegrations per minute beta, both per 100 square centimeters exposure room floor area. There have been no abnormal occurrences (13c). There have been no maintenance or repair activities related to the exposure room (13d). There have been no other significant activities involving DORF residual reactor radioactivity, other than that being planned as described in the memorandum referenced at paragraph 1b.
