
Due to a change in NRC licensing policy, total possession limits for all regulated materials need to be listed on all NRC licenses. Based on information we already have, we have listed the total possession limit for nickel-63 on your license. It is our understanding that you will apply for a termination of your NRC license your two gas chromatographs are generally licensed. A timely termination request to your NRC license is expected soon.

Enclosed is a corrected copy to your NRC license as a result of this change in licensing policy. Please carefully review these changes.
