Response to Inspection Report 80-24

WPSC has reviewed inspection report 80-24 and the circumstances surrounding the alleged non-compliance. Recognizing its significance, WPSC has already taken steps to correct the deficiency identified by the item of non-compliance. These actions include the transfer of responsibility in this area to an onsite supervisor to address fire protection concerns. The specific item of non-compliance was identified as:

> "....the inspector verified by review of Work Requests and Ignition Control Sheets that Administrative Control Directive 10.6 - Revision C, Part 5.2, concerning fire watch requirements during ignition source work is not being implemented. Specifically, Work Request 15362 involved grinding in the containment and no fire watch requirements were specified."

WPSC has taken or intends to take the following corrective measures with regard to this item of non-compliance.

- 1. Work request 15362 and the requirements of ACD 10.6 have been reviewed with the personnel involved.
- 2. The ACD controlling Ignition Control Sheets will be revised to ensure the proper performance of fire watch requirements. Refresher training on the requirements of ACD 10.6 will be given to the appropriate personnel after the ACD has been revised.

3. ACD 10.6 will be revised by March 2, 1981.





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
