NRC STAFF ERRATA TO BRIEF IN RESPONSE TO THE LICENSING BOARD'S
FOURTH SET OF QUESTIONS REGARDING ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff hereby submits the following errata to its June 16, 2011 brief¹ responding to the Licensing Board's Memorandum and Order (Providing Presentation Topics, Additional Questions, and Administrative Directives Associated with Mandatory Hearing on Environmental Matters) of June 2, 2011.² In a June 21, 2011 Memorandum and Order,³ the Licensing Board directed the staff to submit (1) the document the staff proposed marking as exhibit NRCR00077 in its June 16, 2011 submission as an entirely new prefiled exhibit and (2) a revised version of prefiled exhibit NRC000184 that reflects any citation revisions required by the resubmission of the document previously submitted as NRCR00077. In response to the Board's June 21, 2011 Memorandum and Order, the staff is submitting NRC000189, which contains a complete version of NUREG-1748, "Environmental Review Guidance for Licensing Actions Associated with NMSS Programs," and NRCR00184, which contains the staff's response to the Licensing Board's fourth set of questions on environmental matters with citations to NRCR00077 revised to NRC000189.
