Dear Mr. Goshen:

Holtec International is planning to submit a License Amendment Request (LAR) for the HI-STORM FW MPC Storage System to the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC) under the provisions of 10CFR72 Subpart L in September 2011. The initial Certificate of Compliance for this system was effective June 13, 2011.

The focus of the LAR will be on alternate heat load patterns for both the MPC-37 and MPC-89 Multi-Purpose Canisters. This LAR will benefit users who have already loaded much of their "cold" fuel into dry storage and those wishing to reduce spent fuel pool inventories in a more accelerated manner.

This letter is sent to inform you of the LAR in lieu of holding a pre-submittal meeting which we don't believe to be necessary in light of the straightforward nature of the proposed amendment. As the submittal will involve review by only one (thermal) discipline, we would respectfully request an expedited review.
