Dear Mr. James:

We are presently completing our review of the approved guarantees of payment of deferred retrospective premiums submitted by operators of power reactors over 100 Nw(e) in connection with the requirements of Section 140.21 of 10 CFR Part 140.

We find, however, that while you have indicated your desire to meet this guarantee through annual reports and projections evidencing an available cash flow equal to \$10 million for each operating reactor, the financial information you have furnished is not sufficient for us to determine that you have satisfied the Section 140.21 requirements.

Therefore, we would appreciate your providing us by March 6, 1978, either more complete financial information as outlined in your telephone conversations with Mr. Ira Dinitz of my staff or some other type of guarantee of retrospective premium as set forth in my letter of June 15, 1977.
