

1. Separation of control and safety instrumentation:

The portion concerning the nuclear steam supply system is being handled by Westinghouse on a non-project basis. Westinghouse had been in periodic contact with the AEC and a final topical report is expected to be submitted to AEC in April, 1969. Information with respect to other balance of plant safeguard items will be submitted by late summer, 1969.

- 2. Information concerning the four items listed under the heading "Containment Design Features" would be submitted by early fall, 1969.
- 3. Accidental dewatering of the Spent Fuel Pool:

The above title is substituted for Item 3 "Tornado Criteria for Spent Fuel" of your letter, as the result of an expanded scope of investigation which includes

March 21, 1969 Dr. Peter A. Morris Page 2 all accidental causes for water removal at a rate beyond the normal makeup capability. Design information is being developed and would be submitted to AEC by the middle of summer, 1969. The environmental monitoring program, site emergency plans and R&D programs have not yet progressed to the point that firm information could be submitted for your review at this time. We shall strive to provide an early submittal in this regard. If you have any questions or comments, on the tentative schedule outlined above, we shall be pleased to discuss them at your convenience.
