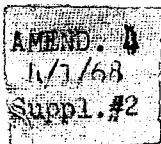
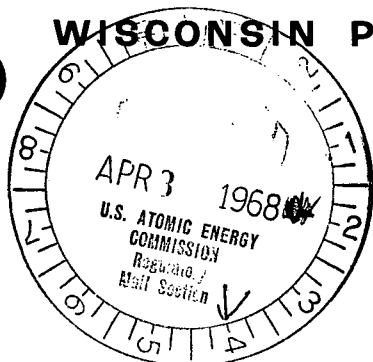

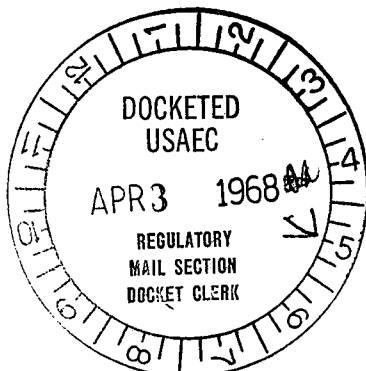
After you have had an opportunity to review this document, we stand ready to discuss it with you.


