On May 25, 1977, we submitted a revised Security Program for the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant to the NRC in response to 10 CFR 73.55 requirements. That revised program received a preliminary staff review which was followed by a mid-August meeting between the NRC review team and our personnel. During that meeting the draft questions generated by the NRC staff on our revised security program were discussed. We agreed to provide a second revision to the Security Program to address the NRC questions on the first revision submitted on May 25, 1977. The staff agreed to provide a revised set of questions which would be addressed in the second revision of the Security Plan.

Consistent with the NRC Staff position, we agreed to submit the second revision to the program in 90 days with the understanding that the transmittal of unresolved questions on the first draft of the Security Program would be provided by the NRC in a timely manner.


The transmittal of the NRC questions arrived in our office on November 17, 1977, one day after the scheduled date of submittal. In addition to the delayed receipt of staff questions, the development of specific design features in the security system has not progressed as well as we optimistically projected. Since the revised manual will describe the systems to be installed and the final design has not yet been completed, a delay in the submittal of the revision to the program will be necessary.

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Based upon progress to date in design and development of the program, we anticipate submittal of the revised program by January 1, 1978. Since your review is scheduled to begin after that date, we trust no delay in the entire review process will result.
