Reference: Letter from E. R. Mathews to D. G. Eisenhut dated November 23, 1981, transmitting proposed Amendment 48 to the KNPP Technical Specifications

On November 23, 1981, we submitted proposed Amendment 48 to the Kewaunee Technical Specifications for your consideration. Since that submittal we have had conversations with your staff during which we agreed to provide a revision to the specification 3.10.e which would clarify the specification. The revision accompanies this letter.

Specifically, we have revised pages 3.10-6, 3.10-6a, 3.10-18, 3.10-19 and 3.10-20. On page 3.10-6, specification 3.10.e is revised as follows:

- An introductory sentence is added which specifies the various methods which can be used to determine the magnitude of a rod cluster control assembly misalignment.
- The parenthetical word "indicated" has been deleted from the body of specification 3.10.e.1 and 3.10.e.2.

On page 3.10-18, a new section entitled "Rod Misalignment Limitations" has been inserted.

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On page 3.10-19, reference 4, which was deleted upon the issuance of Amendment 36 to the KNPP Technical Specifications, has been replaced. This reference is the Rod Misalignment Analysis which was performed by WPSC in July of this year.

Since these changes are non-substantive and only serve to clarify proposed Amendment 48, the safety analyses provided in the referenced letter are still applicable.

Pursuant to the requirements of 10 CFR 50.90, three signed originals of this letter and forty copies of the pages affected by this revision are included in this package.
