We have looked into the origin of the two technical specification (TS) discrepancies which you recently brought to the attention of our staff. The following is a description of each discrepancy and our proposed corrective actions.

Table TS 4.1-2

Wisconsin Public Service Corporation's (WPSC) proposed TS amendment No. 55 dated August 24, 1983 added two footnotes (numbered 1 and 2) to Table TS 4.1-2 which clarified the requirements for boron concentration testing of the reactor coolant system and the refueling water storage tank. This revision was subsequently approved by Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Amendment No. 63 dated July 5, 1985.

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WPSC subsequently submitted proposed TS amendment No. 66 which proposed additional revisions to the first page of Table TS 4.1-2. This revision inadvertently deleted the references to footnotes 1 and 2. This amendment was approved on July 29, 1985 as NRC Approved Amendment No. 64, and contained the error on page 1 of Table TS 4.1-2 which we had submitted.

Our action to correct this error is to request that you revise Table TS 4.1-2 by reinserting the references to footnotes 1 and 2, and distribute this page along with our proposed amendment No. 76 which contains miscellaneous TS changes. We understand that, since proposed amendment No. 76 is currently under review by the NRC, this arrangement is acceptable to you. Also, it may be beneficial to label this page, "Page 1 of 2."

Page TS 6-5

NRC Approved Amendment No. 60, page TS 6-4, item (h) dealt with the subject of PORC review of the Security Plan, the Emergency Plan, and their implementing procedures. Item (h) continued onto page TS 6-5 which read, "changes to the Vice President-Power Production". WPSC's subsequent proposed amendment No. 55 revised items (e) through (h) on page TS 6-4 and correctly removed the aforementioned phrase from the top of page TS 6-5. This revision was subsequently approved by NRC Amendment No. 63 dated July 5, 1985.

On March 29, 1985, WPSC proposed additional changes to page TS 6-5. Page TS 6-5 was transmitted containing the phrase "changes to the Vice President-Power Production", which was appropriate since NRC Amendment No. 63 had not yet been issued. This page was subsequently approved by NRC on July 29, 1985. At this time the erroneous phrase should have been removed by NRC. To correct this error, we request that you revise and reissue this page along with our proposed amendment No. 76.

Since the above changes are purely administrative in nature and have been previously approved by NRC, they do not involve a safety concern. There are no significant hazards associated with these changes.

The attachment to this letter provides our revised Table TS 4.1-2 (page 1 of 2) and TS 6-5.

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.30, enclosed please find three (3) signed and notarized transmittal letters and forty (40) copies of the affected pages described above. In accordance with 10 CFR 170, a check for \$150 was previously submitted with our proposed amendment No. 76 which encompasses the changes provided herein. In accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.91(b)(1), a copy of this letter has been transmitted to the State of Wisconsin.
