JOINT FILING ON ADMINISTRATIVE ISSUES

On June 2, 2011, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Licensing Board") issued a Memorandum and Order (Providing Presentation Topics, Additional Questions, and Administrative Directives Associated with Mandatory Hearing on Environmental Matters). In the Order, the Licensing Board requested that the parties provide the Licensing Board with a submission indicating (a) which party will be taking the lead on each of the presentation topics designated by the Board; (b) whether there will be any supplemental presentation by the non-lead party as to each designated topic; (c) relative to each of the designated topics, a preliminary estimate as to how long each lead party and non-lead party presentation will take and how many witnesses will be involved in each lead party and non-lead party presentation; (d) information regarding witness availability; and (e) whether any lead or supplemental presentation will involve the discussion of proprietary/sensitive information that would require any portion of the mandatory hearing to be closed to the public.

The requested information is provided below on behalf of both AREVA Enrichment Services LLC ("AES") and the NRC Staff.

<u>Presentation Topic 1: Purpose and Need for the Proposed Action</u>

- a) Lead party: AES (3 witnesses)
- b) No supplemental presentation by the NRC Staff is currently anticipated though NRC will have 2 witnesses available at the hearing to answer questions related to this topic
- c) Estimated presentation time: 120 minutes

Presentation Topic 2: "Preconstruction" Activities

- a) Lead party: AES (2 witnesses)
- b) No supplemental presentation by the NRC Staff is currently anticipated though NRC will have 2 witnesses available at the hearing to answer questions related to this topic
- c) Estimated presentation time: 60 minutes

<u>Presentation Topic 3: Greenhouse Gas Impacts of Facility's Production Power</u> Consumption

- a) Lead party: NRC Staff (1 witness)
- b) No supplemental presentation by AES is currently anticipated
- c) Estimated presentation time: 30 minutes

Presentation Topic 4: Preconstruction and Construction Air Quality Impacts

- a) Lead party: NRC Staff (1 witness)
- b) No supplemental presentation by AES is currently anticipated
- c) Estimated presentation time: 40 minutes

Presentation Topic 5: Radiological Effluent Monitoring Program (REMP)

- a) Lead party: NRC Staff (3 witnesses)
- b) No supplemental presentation by AES is currently anticipated though AES will have 2 witnesses available at the hearing to answer questions related to this topic
- c) Estimated presentation time: 60 minutes

<u>Presentation Topic 6: Historic/Cultural Resources Memorandum of Agreement and Associated Mitigation Measures</u>

- a) Lead party: NRC Staff (2 witnesses)
- b) No supplemental presentation by AES is currently anticipated
- c) Estimated presentation time: 20 minutes

The parties will provide a list of witnesses for each topic, as well as make available a resume/statement of professional qualifications for each witness at the time

presentation materials are filed (*i.e.*, on or before July 1, 2011). The parties are not presently aware of any limitations related to the availability of planned witnesses for any of the presentation topics, though the preference is to conduct the hearing in the order of the presentation topics listed above. In addition, at this time, the parties do not anticipate that any lead or supplemental presentations will involve the discussion of proprietary/sensitive information that would require any portion of the mandatory hearing to be closed to the public.
