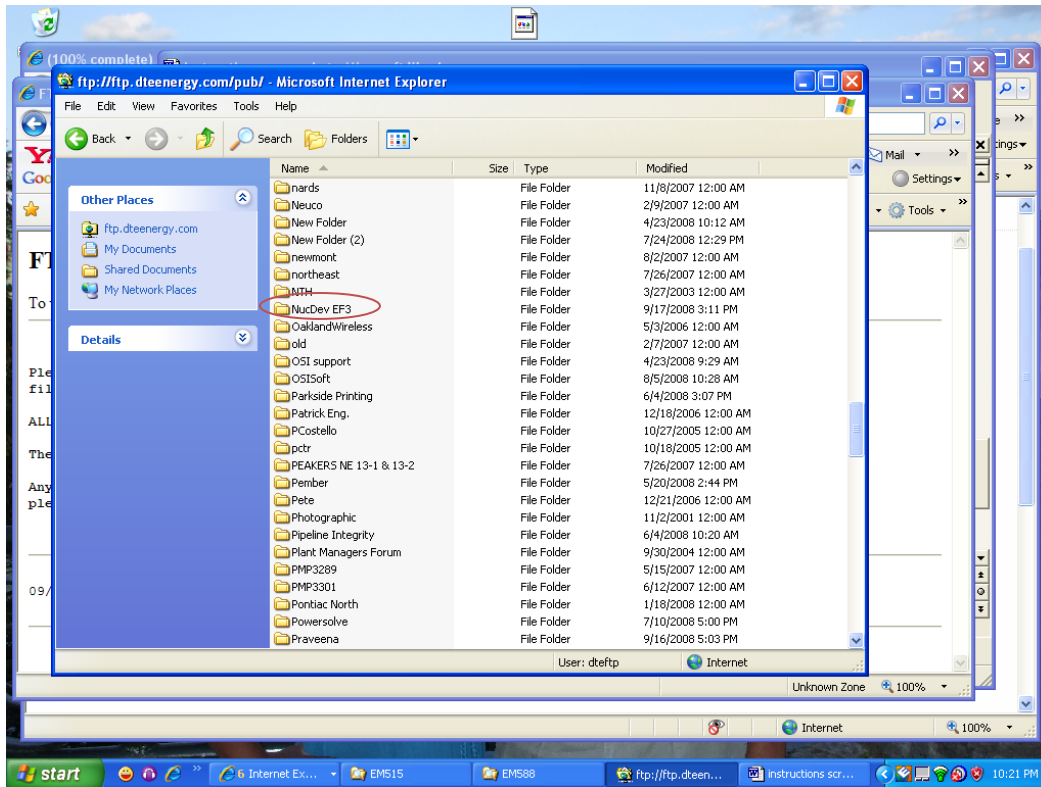
1. In an internet explorer window type: [ftp.dteenergy.com](ftp://ftp.dteenergy.com) as the address.
2. Login as: dteftp
3. Password: edison
4. Click Directory pub link at bottom of page (see above)



5. Click Page Icon in right hand corner of Internet Explorer (see above)



6. Select Open FTP Site in Windows Explorer (see above)



7. Create a folder and notify your sender/receiver the name of the folder
8. Copy and paste the information into the folder.
