Reference 1 described the requalification exams to be administered at the Kewaunee plant in February of 1992. A program evaluation will also be performed at this time. Reference 2 provided a schedule for the administration of future requalification exams. In addition to the February Exam, reference 2 indicates Kewaunee is also scheduled for an examination in August of 1992.

Upon successful completion of the scheduled exams in February, requalification exams will be completed for all operators until 1996 when one senior reactor license will be due for renewal. Since the next license renewal will not be required until 1996 and a program evaluation will be completed in February of 1992, Wisconsin Public Service Corporation is proposing that the next requalification exam be scheduled for May of 1993. Elimination of the requalification exam scheduled for August of 1992 will decrease the burden on the NRC's and the licensee's limited resources without decreasing the level of Operator qualification.
