Dear Mr. Sunseri:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations regarding activities at Wolf Creek Generating Station. The Office of Investigations initiated the investigation to determine whether a former contract health physics boundary guard at the Wolf Creek Generating Station was discriminated against as the result of raising safety concerns.

Based upon the evidence developed, this investigation did not substantiate the allegation that the health physics boundary guard was discriminated against as the result of raising safety concerns. The NRC plans no further action related to the discrimination aspect of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
