On June 22, 2011, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received the Exelon Generation Company, LLC's application for renewal of operating licenses for the Limerick Generating Station, Units 1 and 2. We are currently performing an acceptance review for docketing in accordance with the requirements of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Section 2.101 (10 CFR 2.101), and will notify you of the results of our review. Should the NRC staff determine that the application is acceptable for docketing, a schedule for the review will then be provided to you.

We have enclosed for your information a copy of the notice relating to your application that is being sent to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.

I am pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Robert F. Kuntz as the project manager for the safety review, and Ms. Lisa M. Regner as the project manager for the environmental review of your license renewal application. Please forward copies of all license renewal correspondence to Mr. Rob Kuntz. Mr. Peter J. Bamford continues to remain responsible for the project management of all issues other than license renewal for Limerick Generating Station.

NOTICE OF RECEIPT AND AVAILABILITY OF APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF

LIMERICK GENERATING STATION, UNITS 1 AND 2

FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE NOS. NPF-39 AND NPF-85

FOR AN ADDITIONAL 20-YEAR PERIOD

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC or Commission) has received an application, dated June 22, 2011, from Exelon Generation Co., LLC, filed pursuant to Section 103 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 54 (10 CFR Part 54), to renew the operating licenses for the Limerick Generating Station (LGS), Units 1 and 2. Renewal of the licenses would authorize the applicant to operate each facility for an additional 20-year period beyond the period specified in the respective current operating licenses. The current operating license for LGS, Unit 1 (NPF-39), expires on October 26, 2024. The current operating license for LGS, Unit 2 (NPF-85), expires on June 22, 2029. Both units are boiling-water reactors designed by General Electric, and are located 4 miles from Limerick, PA. The acceptability of the tendered application for docketing and other matters, including an opportunity to request a hearing, will be the subject of subsequent *Federal Register* notices.


