To the Members of the NRC:

I am appalled to learn that Energy Solutions of Oak Ridge, TN has applied for a license to import up to 1000 tons of radioactive waste from Europe and transport this waste to Oak Ridge to be incinerated.

We need to know what kind of waste and what levels of radioactivity are to be brought into our country, how much radiation people would be exposed to all along the line, how much would escape into the atmosphere during the burning process and how the NRC will ensure that the ash returns to its place of origin.

We should be told how much foreign waste is already here and how it has been disposed of.

We U.S. Citizens should have ample time to become informed and have a say in whether we want nuclear waste brought into our country – as if we didn't have enough already that isn't being properly and safely disposed of!

Rather than being quietly approved during the holiday season, we need at least a month or so extension time for public comments and responses.

This is still our country.
