### Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with Reference 1, and as approved by the Commission per Reference 2, Southern Nuclear Operating Company commits to submit the License Amendment Request (LAR) implementing 10 CFR 50.48(c) for Farley Nuclear Plant (FNP) Units 1 and 2 by September 30, 2012. Additional time beyond July 1, 2012 is needed for several reasons. First, time is needed to complete a fire PRA model that provides realistic insights and that can be submitted for a successful industry peer team review. Second, limited availability of fire contractor resources to SNC has extended the LAR submittal schedule.

Finally, preparation for a potential June 2011 partial LAR submittal shifted resources, resulting in a schedule delay. This schedule extension will not result in a reduction in our focus to complete this work in an expeditious manner. There is no safety impact associated with this extension since the current Appendix R licensing basis continues to remain in effect.

This is a change to the schedule submitted in Reference 3. In addition, Southern Nuclear Operating Company requests that the enforcement discretion be extended to correspond to the LAR submittal commitment date. Per the enforcement discretion policy, once the LAR is submitted, the enforcement discretion would then continue until the NRC dispositions the LAR to transition to NFPA 805, consistent with Reference 1.
