Please find enclosed corrected copy to Amendment Number 12 to NRC License Number 50-23289-01. The NRC has established that all materials licenses should have maximum possession limits listed on materials licenses as recommended by the Materials Program Working Group (MPWG) of the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME). Previously, your license had an "open ended" possession limit described in Item 8 of your materials license. **The attached corrected copy contains a "closed ended" possession limit, which specifies the maximum amount of activity per source and total activity allowed for each radioisotope on the license.
