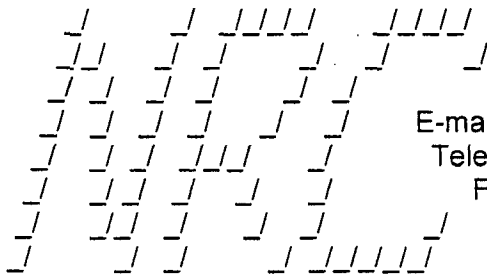
Good Morning Tanny!


