Dear Mr. Schrock:

Thank you for your letter dated January 29, 1993, informing us of your intent to revise the Quality Assurance (QA) audit frequency for the Technical Specifications, Operating License, and Radwaste Program/Low Level shipments audits from annually to biennially. We have reviewed your proposed reduction in these QA commitments made in docketed correspondence outside of the Quality Assurance Program description. Questions resulting from this review were discussed between Mr. F. Maura of this office and Ms. B. Domnick of your staff on February 19, 1993. As a result of these discussions, we understand that your first request to change the audit frequency for the Revision and Control of the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant Technical Specifications (TS) and Operating License Audit is not a requirement of TS 6.5.3.8. Thus, this reduction in commitment meets the requirements of the TS and 10 CFR 50, Appendix B. The second change request to the audit frequency for the Radwaste Program/Low Level Shipments Audit specified in TS 6.5.3.8.j already has a biannual audit frequency requirement. Our conclusion regarding this request is that it also continues to meet the requirements of 10 CFR 50, Appendix B and the TS. Therefore, we find that both your requests are acceptable. However, any changes in your audit schedule which conflict with your TS 6.5.3.8 requirements will require a license amendment.

If there are changes to QA commitments existing in docketed correspondence outside of the Quality Assurance Program description, you are obligated to notify this office.
