Reference 1) NRC's Final Policy Statement on Technical Specifications Improvements
for Nuclear Power Reactors (58 FR 39132), dated 7/22/93.

A revision to Technical Specification (TS) 3.4, "Steam and Power Conversion System", is being proposed for the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant (KNPP) to remove the Limiting Conditions for Operation (LCOs) for the Turbine Overspeed Protection System (TOPS). Revisions to Tables TS 4.1-1 and T.S. 4.1-3 are also being proposed for the KNPP to remove the surveillance requirements for the TOPS instrumentation and turbine valves. In addition, Wisconsin Public Service Corporation is revising the basis for TS sections 3.4 and 4.1 to be consistent with these changes.

The purpose for proposing these changes is to relocate the TOPS and related requirements from the TSs to the Updated Safety Analysis Report (USAR) while maintaining KNPP's existing surveillance procedures. An evaluation of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Policy Statement Criteria (Reference 1) was performed to determine if TOPS and related requirements should remain in the KNPP TSs. This evaluation determined that the TOPS did not satisfy any of the NRC Policy Statement Criteria. As a result, it was recommended that the TOPS and related requirements be removed from the TSs.


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Attachment 1 to this proposed amendment (PA) request contains a description of the proposed changes, a safety evaluation, a significant hazards determination and environmental considerations. Attachment 2 contains revisions to the affected pages in sections TS 3.4 and its basis, TS 4.1 basis, Table 4.1-1, and Table 4.1-3. 
