Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPSC) hereby provides notification of implementation of ASME Code Case N-356 at the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Plant (KNPP), as permitted by 10 CFR 55a(g). WPSC must comply with the requirements of the 1980 Edition through Winter 1981 Addenda of Section XI of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code for KNPP. In accordance with this document, any personnel performing a Level III non-destructive examination (NDE) shall be recertified by qualification examinations every three years. ASME Code Case N-356 allows the certification period for Level III NDE personnel to be extended to five years.

As stated in Regulatory Guide 1.147 revision 9, Code Case N-356 is "acceptable to the NRC staff for implementation in the inservice inspection of light-water-cooled nuclear power plants." As a result of this approval, KNPP will implement Code Case N-356 for qualification of Level III NDE personnel.
